- **Principal's Report:**

- Cafeteria Committee:

Generally this committee meets prior to each CSCC meeting

- Activities being run at St Peter's:

Basketball, Football, X-Country, Soccer, Tennis, Flag Football, Volleyball  
Football – had trouble recruiting for a new coach due to departure of 3 coaches from last season; 3 days/wk, 6am practices – students helping out Coach Shane – need to rebuild for next year with more coaches.

- Homework Help:

4 days/week (Mo-Tu-We-Th), in addition to Mind-To-Math  
Held in Commons Room (central location)

- Activity & Club sign-up:

On Monday September 25, 2017; tables will be set up in front foyer of school to promote awareness and attract students to participate.

- New Technology – Learning commons – request for Chromebooks/Basketball Uniforms:

Another set of Chromebooks are being requested (\$12,500 for set of 30)  
Paul Zyla, coach basketball – requested money to purchase new uniforms for the senior boys basketball team – requesting \$1,500 (\$100/uniform was quoted, he would like 15)  
Cafeteria account has ~\$50,000  
Unanimous decision by council to fund both requests (~\$15,000 total)
